OUR INVESTMENT IN SCOTT COUNTY, IOWA

As part of this sustained initiative, we're investing to upgrade the Waste Commission of Scott County's (WCSC) Materials Recovery Facility (MRF) to allow for enhanced collection and sorting of valuable recyclable materials, like our 100% recyclable bottles.



INVESTING \$600,000 To upgrade the county's MRF

This investment will help upgrade the MRF by adding three new optical sorters to increase the MRF's ability to sort, clean, process and bale recyclable materials, such as the beverage industry's 100% plastic beverage bottles.



INCREASING RECYCLABLE MATERIALS COLLECTED IN THE REGION

Over the next 10 years, the investment is projected to yield over 26,000 tons of recycled material including over 2,700 tons of polyethylene terephthalate (PET) and 498 tons of aluminum.



REVITALIZING THE COUNTY'S RECYCLING PROGRAM

The WCSC MRF upgrade will revitalize the county's recycling program by increasing the inbound capacity of valuable materials, like the beverage industry's 100% recyclable bottles and cans, from municipalities in Illinois and lowa to ensure that PET bottles remain in the recycling stream and can be remade, as intended.
