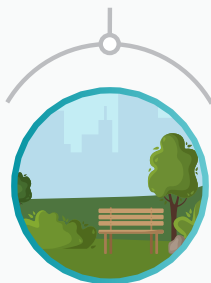
INVESTING \$97,500 TO UPGRADE RECYCLING PROGRAMS

We're making investments to provide residents with free, lidded 65-gallon curbside carts that will increase the capacity of recyclables collected, improve recycling rates and help prevent plastic from ending up in the environment.



EXPANDING CURBSIDE RECYCLING ACCESS TO 6,500 HOUSEHOLDS

We're making recycling accessible and convenient by providing 6,500 households with upgraded curbside carts.



INCREASING RECYCLABLE MATERIALS COLLECTED IN THE REGION

The new curbside carts are projected to collect nearly 8.6 million new pounds of recyclable materials over 10 years, of which 111,800 pounds will be aluminum and 335,400 pounds will be polyethylene terephthalate (PET), both of which are used to make our 100% recyclable cans and bottles.
